In this space we remember millions of displaced people struggling to survive in refugee camps.

Looking at the sea of white 'tents,' imagine the emotions, hopes, and fears of those living in such camps.

- Forced to flee from home in the middle of the night, what would you throw into your rucksack?
- What you would have to leave behind?
- What would life in the camp feel like after a day ... a month ... a year?
- What it would be like to raise a family in this environment?
- How you would feel about your future?

As we reflect on the words written on these tents, use this time to offer your own prayers for the men, women and children trapped in camps in Turkey, Jordan, Iraq, Lebanon, Macedonia, and the border countries of Europe.
